TERMS AND CONDITIONS

By submitting a photograph to the competition you are agreeing to the following terms and conditions:

1. **The theme of this photographic competition is ORGANIC farming, food and drink in Scotland.**
2. Closing date for entries to the competition is close of business on 6th June 2008.
3. There is no limit to the number of entries.
4. The competition is open to amateur photographers only. Professional photographers are not eligible to enter.
5. The judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
6. The winner will be notified by 13th June 2008 by email.
7. The winner's name will be published after 13th June 2008 on the SOPA website www.sopa.org.uk
8. There will be one overall winner and 9 runners-up.
9. The winning entry for the overall first prize will win an organic hamper and two adult tickets to the Royal Highland Show. Tickets are valid for entry on any day during the Show 19th–22nd June. See www.royalhighlandshow.org/ for further information about the Show.
10. There will be 9 runners up who will be entered into a competition run during the Royal Highland Show on the SOPA/SFQC stand on 10th Avenue; this free competition will be open to the public to vote for their favourite entry. An organic hamper will be awarded to the entry with the most votes on conclusion of the Show. All runners-up entries will be displayed on the SOPA/SFQC stand.
11. Each photograph must be original and taken by the entrant.
12. Manipulated or enhanced digital images will not be accepted. The judges reserve the right to disqualify any entry which they believe may be digitally enhanced or manipulated.
13. All photographs must be legally obtained, with permission if appropriate. Please note this includes images of children, where the parent or guardian must give their permission for the photograph to be taken.
14. Entrants must be the sole author and owner of copyright for all pictures entered.
15. On submitting photographs for the competition, the entrant is agreeing to give SOPA and SFQC the right with no restrictions to free reproduction of entries in connection with promotions and publicity at their discretion.
16. All photographs should be submitted in a digital format JPEG file 300 DPI as an individual email attachment no larger than 4mb (zipped if necessary), to deborah.roberts@sfqc.co.uk **No more than one entry per email.** If you do not have access to email, please telephone 0131 335 6619
17. All photographs must be submitted with a completed entry form (see below) **for each entry.**
18. All entries are submitted at the entrant's risk and SOPA/SFQC regrets that they cannot accept liability for damage or loss.
19. All entries will be acknowledged by email.
20. Entries that do not meet the competition terms and conditions will be disqualified.
